Green Up Your Garden with Composting

Composting is easy and saves money! It transforms your kitchen and yard waste into nutrient rich food valuable for your garden. Basically add greens or food scraps and grass (no animal products) with browns such as cardboard, newspaper, dry leaves, twigs and paper towels! Mix organic material into a pile, give it oxygen and water then wait for the end result ~ **compost!**

When planting your garden remember to **recycle** plastic planting pots 5 gallons or smaller in your recycling bin or toter. Seedling plug trays and other pots that crinkle are **trash**. Before recycling, consider reusing the pots or purchase biodegradable pots that can be planted directly into the ground or composted.
