


## **LGBTQ SCI-FIC AND FANTASY**


### ***Willful Machines* by Tim Floreen**


***We Set the Dark on Fire* by Tehlor Kay Mejia**


***Carry On* by Rainbow Rowell**


***They Both Die at the End* by Adam Silvera**


***The Grief Keeper* by Alexandra Villasante**
