SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Utility Cuts: Final road surface restoration shall conform to existing road surface in material and installation. Upon completion of work, permit applicant must contact the Public Services Department for an inspection. All utility cuts shall be patched with approved asphalt mix no later than 3:30 pm on the day of construction.

Infra-red Restoration: Infrared road restoration shall be required for roadways paved within the past 5 years.

Winter Conditions: All excavations performed between November 1 and April 1 shall be backfilled entirely with processed gravel.

Trees: If activity requires removal and/or trimming of trees with Town Right-of-Way, a SK Tree Permit and posting by the Tree Warden is required. An advisory opinion from the Conservation Commission may also be required. **SK Tree Permit #** _____
